- **Review:** Pullman High School – School Improvement Plan
 - Juston provided an overview of the goals for PHS outlined in the school improvement plan.
- **Discussion:** Review survey results from students to determine additional critical action items. Review ranked action items and work on creating action plan.
 - Action items for top 4 priorities:
 - Increase student feedback
 - Conduct student survey
 - Staff started added a feedback box by the office. Will look at adding more in common areas and near classrooms that may be more secure. Can advertise over social media, QR codes to a google form, morning announcements, utilize REMIND accounts, and flyers on tables with information. Ambassadors will also work on informing students that those are available.
 - Connecting students to mental health resources and raise awareness.
 - Ambassadors can connect with Greyhounds Minds Matter club.
 - Continue to promote and raise awareness about school clubs/activities.
 - Ambassadors brainstormed some different activities that could help inform students.
 - Meals at PHS:
 - Lunch line wait times – quick service stations
 - Juston provided a staffing update for decreasing lunch line wait times and opening the snack station was very helpful. The goal is to spread students out and find a way to open another food service station possibly utilizing the aux gym and having students spread out more towards the office.

- The team discussed different incentives for encouraging students to spread out towards the office. Moving the locations of the trash cans could help keep students from congregating in one area.
- Apply for grants to help with the lack of funding.
- Close of stairs to English wing to force the crowd an alternative way with a food service station.
- Vending machines in a more convenient space for students.
- More reminders about students grabbing meals and finding a table to spread out more.
- Expand eating areas
- Ingredient list for meals
- Sustainability at PHS
 - Cecilia and Dominick are student representatives on the district Sustainability Committee.
