Meeting Notes:

➤ Meeting – November 15, 2022

- We had a couple team members out, but reviewed the following:
Great job at the board meeting the week prior.
Discussed where we want to go from here (main focus) - Student survey to orient goals, school garden, food composting, cultural days during lunches, or an evening at PHS, connect with ASB on projects. WSU Teaching and Learning wants to run a podcast with us. They are planning to be at our meeting on the 29th to touch base.

➤ Meeting – November 29, 2022

- Our team met with staff from the Teaching and Learning Dept. from WSU to discuss a potential podcast or video about the student ambassador program. They want to help promote your story about what you are doing as youth leaders. They want to be able to tell your story to the community. The group wanted to know what drew our ambassadors in to join, if students from the general population are coming to talk with you if we need to push our information out to students more. In the end, they want to help support this group. They want to be a part of the process. At our next meeting on Dec 13th, we will discuss what we feel would be the best way for the WSU group to support us.

➤ Meeting – January 10, 2023

- Focus on composting, potentially group up with cultural day.
- Work with ASB on Cultural Day. This project will be second on the list behind composting. However, the group felt they will be able to do some parts simultaneously.
- For composting, the group will research getting new bins and signage. Environmental club makes labels for the bins. Admin will purchase the bins.
- Make a signup sheet for ambassadors and environmental club to work the compost receiving area during lunch time.
- Team wants to make sure we tell our student body why we are making this endeavor. We need to share the why. Suggestion was to give a little walk-through video.
- Final questions were - Where would the garden and compost area be located?

➤ Meeting – January 24, 2023

- Met with WSU group and discussed podcast and a potential zoom. WSU will get us a schedule (potentially the 21st of Feb). WSU wants to provide their students info about high school students (what is important to our young adults).
- We will be looking to partner with WSU and our Environmental Club regarding composting.
- Our group will send the PowerPoints to WSU group to give them a better understanding of Student Ambassadors.
- Composting will have volunteers sign up from the environmental club to begin. Also, we may get help from WSU and the Center for Civic Engagement.
- Two items needed now from our team:
 - Research composting bins are report back to Mr. Pollestad for ordering (Dominic is taking the lead on this one)
 - Video / Instructions on how and why composting is important (could be slides or video, or both)

➤ **Meeting – March 21, 2023**

- AAPI collaboration with WSU - planning to use the theater for presentation on the evening of Friday, 4/14.
- Discussed our progress with composting - ordered bins for the green house area. (We will need students from the environmental club to transport the compost to the appropriate area 3x's a week.
- Conversation about attendance and the school policy/procedure on how we encourage attendance and work with students and families when attendance becomes an issue.
