REQUIREMENTS: 2024 Pullman High School Graduate

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP: **\$2500** - non-recurring scholarship to be used for tuition at the college or university of your choice during the Fall Semester 2024. The scholarship will be paid directly to the College of the successful application's choice on their behalf.
